ATTENDANCE POLICY:

HVYJO is committed to providing its members the opportunity to rehearse and perform with a full ensemble. This requires the commitment of each member to prepare, practice, and be present. Before the first rehearsal and during the season, please continually check your calendar and notify your director immediately of any potential or actual conflicts. Notify your director by phone (914) 466-0480 or email director@bridgeartsandeducation.org in the event of illness. Mandatory school music events take precedence over HVYJO events, but students MUST notify the director well in advance.

More than 2 absences from rehearsals may result in removal from the ensemble (at the discretion of the director).

Any absence without prior notification may result in removal from the group.

informal concerts: Bridge Arts and Education t-shirt, black pants/skirt
