### Bridge Arts and Education hosts virtual workshop for vocalists

**January 4, 2022- Kingston, NY** – Non-profit organization Bridge Arts and Education is hosting an online vocal workshop, “Song Style Bootcamp”, beginning January 18, 2022.

Led by vocalist Rhonda Denet, Song Style Bootcamp is a small group, highly individualized online series to help singers find their own style. In six 90-minute sessions on Zoom, Rhonda will help you tell your story through song. Class enrollment is limited to 6 participants. Each student will leave this series with backing tracks and lead sheets developed specifically for their voice and style. This course is designed for intermediate through advanced vocalists (High School through adult). Some performance experience is recommended. Because this course is entirely online, vocalists in any location are encouraged to join!

Instructor Rhonda Denét is hailed as a virtuoso that lends her flair to every song she sings. When she performs, Denét invites her audience to surrender to the groove by blending classic and contemporary favorites with her inspiring original music. Her repertoire covers the gamut ranging from the American Songbook to Top 40 radio. Based in Jersey City, New Jersey, the jazz/soul vocalist, songwriter and bandleader makes a full-time living doing what she LOVES.
